

Cyberwar The Digital Front – An Attack on Freedom and Democracy?

Cyberattacks happen on a daily basis and expose national security. How safe is our energy and water supply, and how safe are we from Internet attacks, cybercrime and espionage? In the Web, national borders blur. Who or what can protect us from anonymous attackers or the "warzone Internet"?

They point at the huge number of cyberattacks that happen every day. Felix FX Lindner emphasizes the exposure of national security by Google and an irresponsible handling of IT security in general.
